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Klein Constantia

2004 Madame Marlbrook Constantia (\$20; a blend of 52% semillon, 22% chardonnay, 19% sauvignon blanc and 7% muscat; aged 11 months in new and used French *barriques*): Medium yellow. Complex nose melds dried stone fruits, smoke and honey, plus a whiff of more tropical fruits. **Concentrated, sexy wine** but a bit youthfully tight and ungiving today owing to its apparent acidity. A bit of residual sugar (5.1 g/l) softens the wine's edge, though. Finishes with a nutty nuance. **89**.
